



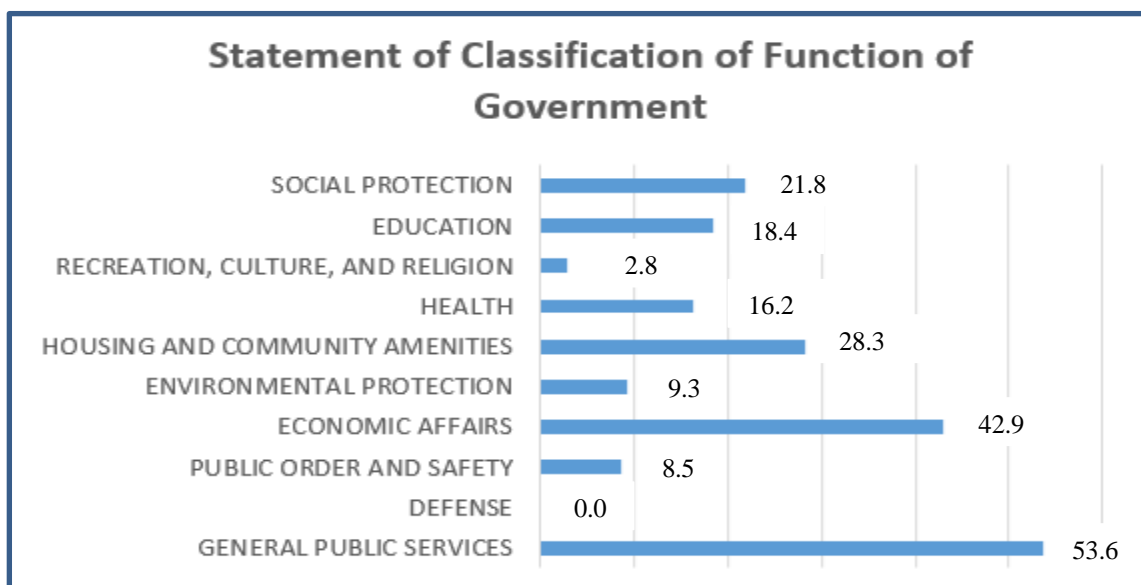

GOVERNMENT FINANCE STATISTICS
FY2018/19

This data series presents a preliminary unaudited statement of Cook Islands government operations and classifications of the functions of government (COFOG) over one fiscal year.

The total government revenue for the year 2018/2019 was \$232.9 million. The five percent increase in revenue, compared to previous fiscal year, was largely due to the increase in taxation revenue, which generated \$18 million more than last fiscal year. Government expenditure, for the current fiscal year, was \$167.3 million, with the largest contribution coming from 'use of goods and services.' As a result, the total net operating balance for the year 2018/2019 was \$65.5 million.

As shown in the graph below, classification of functions of government resulted in a total of \$201.9 million. The largest contributor to functions of government was from the general public services with more than twenty five percent contribution.
